The Writing Process of a Narrative Paragraph: Revise

Step 1: Read

Time-Order Words


- then
- soon
- first
- later
- next
- now



Time-order words tell when things happen in a story.



In the morning, I get up and get dressed.



Then I go to the toilet and wash hands.



Next, I brush my teeth and wash my face.


