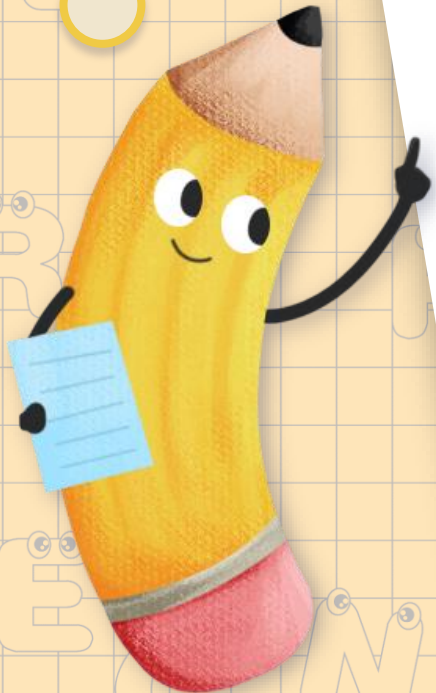

### A. **We Should Do Exercise**

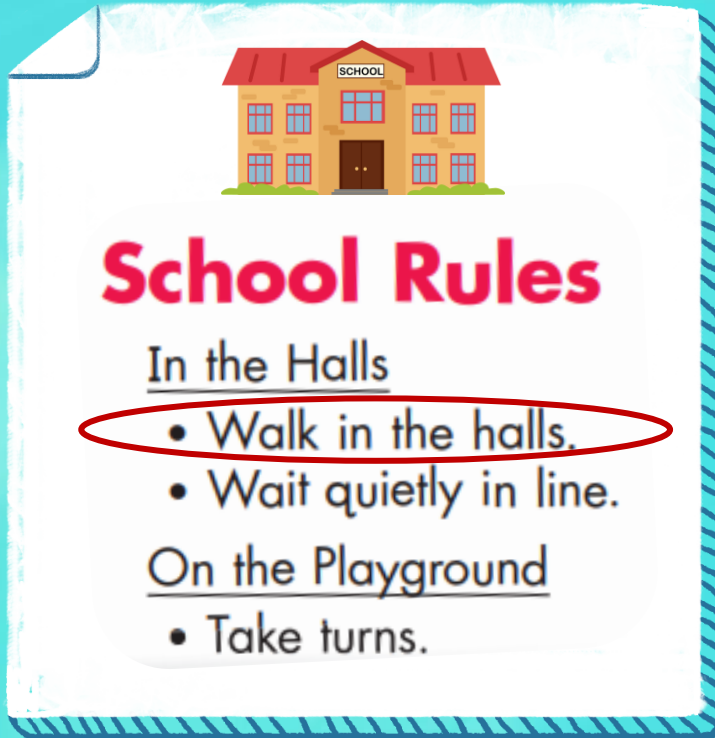
We should do exercise every day.
