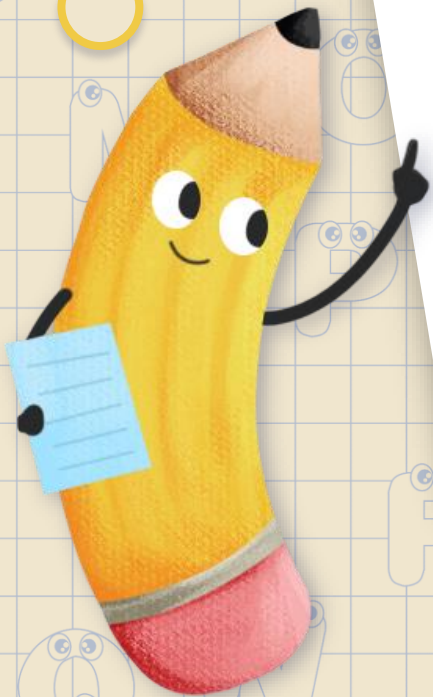

Persuasive

A writing that gives reasons why others should agree with you.



Three (3) points to remember when writing to persuade:

1. Use the word “**should**” sentence that tells your opinion to start writing.
2. Think about reasons to make others agree. **Write one sentence for each reason.**
3. Repeat your opinion **in a new way** in the end.
