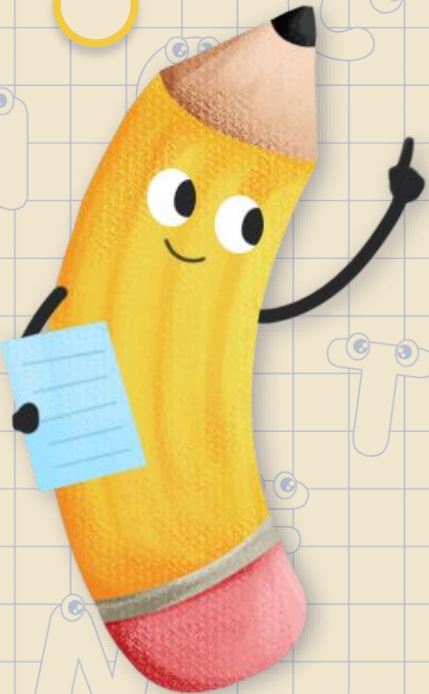

Step 1: Read
