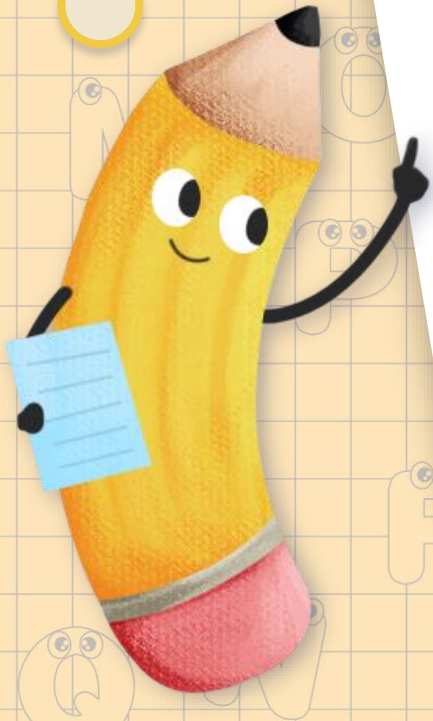

Let's Review

A story has three parts.

Beginning

- The beginning names the **main character** and the **setting**. It also tells about the **problem**.

Middle

- The middle tells **how the main character tries to solve the problem**.

Ending

- The ending tells **how the problem is solved** and **how the main character feels**.

A Smart Rabbit

One morning in the field, a little rabbit wants to pick up a pumpkin. But the pumpkin is too big for her to carry. She thinks it over but she has no idea. Later, a panda with a bike passes by. Looking at the round wheels, the rabbit has an idea. She rolls it on the ground like a wheel. Now she can carry it!

You can draw a sketch to plan a story. We need to plan the **Beginning**, **Middle**, and **Ending** parts.

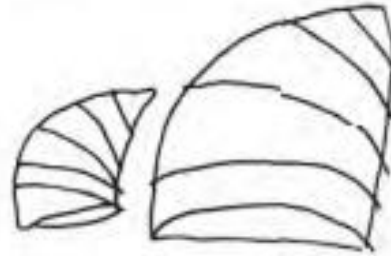
