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R.E.M.S. METHOD

F1 Slides 1 & 2

DISCUSSION (noun)

Definition: It is the activity in which people talk about something and tell each other their ideas or opinions.

The discussion is on Monday.

EXAM (noun)

Definition: An "exam" is a test of a student's knowledge or skill in a particular subject.

The school exam is in April.

THEATER (noun)

Definition: A "theater" is a room or a place where a show is done on a stage.

The theater in the school is open at lunchtime.

TOPIC (noun)

Definition: The word "topic" means the subject of what you talk about.

The topic of the discussion in the morning is an adjective.

REVIEW (verb)

Definition: To "review" means to study again a topic or lessons at school.

He reviews his notes in science at night.

REVIEW (noun)

Definition: As a noun, it means the process of studying a lesson or subject again.

The review starts on May 21.

MATH (noun) SCIENCE (noun) GEOGRAPHY (noun) ENGLISH (noun)

Definition: Math, Science, English, and Geography are subjects we study at school.

Please bring your math, science, English, and geography books to the class on Tuesday.

PLAY (verb)

Definition: To "play" means to do activities for fun or enjoyment.

Children play games.

BASKETBALL (noun) TENNIS (noun)

Definition: Basketball and tennis are sports we play with a ball.

He plays basketball.

Maria Sharapova plays tennis.

FOOTBALL (noun) SOCCER (noun)

Definition: In England, "soccer" is called "football". American football is also a ball game in

America but not the same as soccer. American football is also known as 'Rugby'.

She plays football at the weekend.

Soccer is my favorite sport.

SPORT (noun)

Definition: A "sport" is a game or event played according to rules.

Some examples of sports are football, tennis, basketball, and soccer.

PLAYER (noun)

Definition: A player is someone who plays sports or games.

Maria Sharapova is a tennis player.

WIN (verb)

Definition: To "win" means to achieve first place in a contest or game.

Maria Sharapova won the game.

She wins the tennis competition.

WINNER (noun)

Definition: A "winner" is someone who wins a game, competition, contest or election.

Maria Sharapova is the winner.

They are winners.

COMPETITION (noun)

Definition: A sport competition is a game of sport where players play hard to win.

They win the football competition.

He wins the tennis competition.

PAINTING (noun)

Definition: This is a painting. A painting is a picture which someone has painted.

An example of a painting is Mona Lisa by Leonardo da Vinci.

The painting on the wall is beautiful.

ART (noun)

Definition: The word "art" means the creation of works of beauty. Painting, music etc. are some examples of arts.

Painting is an art.

PAINT (noun)

Definition: The word "paint" means a colored liquid that is put on a surface such as a wall to decorate it.

I like red paint.

PAINT (verb)

Definition: To “paint” means to apply color or paint to a surface.

He paints well.

COOK (verb)

Definition: To “cook” means to prepare food or meals by using heat.

I cook breakfast.

MOVIE (noun)

Definition: A “movie” is a series of moving images shown on a screen, usually with sound, that make up a story.

For example, “We watch movies on television or on the big screen in the theater.”

Avatar is a movie.

FILM (noun)

Definition: The word “film” is another word for movie.

She watches a film in the theater.

PIANO (noun)

Definition: A piano is a large musical instrument with a row of black and white keys.

She plays the piano every Saturday.

PRIZE (noun)

Definition: A “prize” is a thing given as a reward to the winner of a competition.

\$100 is the prize for the tennis competition.

TOY (noun)

Definition: A “toy” is an object that is made for a child to play with.

The boy has many toys.

TENT (noun)

Definition: This is a tent.

We will sleep in the big tent tonight.

The toy is in the tent.

PARK (noun)

Definition: A “park” is a public area of land with grass and trees where people go in order to relax and enjoy themselves.

She plays in the park on Saturdays.

RACE (noun)

Definition: It is a competition between people, animals, or vehicles to see who or which is the fastest.

A horse race, for example, is a competition between horses to see which one is the fastest.

We watch a car race.

RACING (noun)

Definition: The word "racing" is a competition in races.

She likes horse racing.

SHOT (noun)

Definition: The word "shot" means a kick, a throw, or a hit of the ball that scores a point in a game.

For example, "The basketball player did 5 shots in the game."

He makes a good shot.

QUIT (verb)

Definition: To "quit" means to leave a job, a school, etc.

For example, "She quit her job because she didn't like it."

He quits basketball.

PRACTICE (verb)

Definition: To "practice" is to do something regularly in order to be able to do it better.

They practice football every day.

PRACTICE (noun)

Definition: It is the act of doing something repeatedly to improve your skill.

His tennis practice is every day.

The basketball practice is on Monday.

TRAIN (verb)

Definition: To "train" is to learn the skills that you need in order to do it.

The players train basketball every day.

THROW (verb)

Definition: It means to move out of your hand and through the air by quickly moving your arm forward.

I am throwing my pen.

He throws the ball.

TECHNOLOGY (noun)

Because of technology, we have cell phones, computers, etc.

Some examples of modern technologies are computers, cell phones, and CDs.

DESK (noun)

Definition: It is a table that has drawers.

The teacher put her books on the desk.

She is pushing the desk.

MOMENT (noun)

Definition: It means a short period of time. By the words “at the moment”, we mean now.
She is studying at the moment.

TEXT (noun)

Definition 1: It is a short written message that you send or receive using a mobile phone.
I am using a mobile phone to send a text message to him.

Definition 2: As a verb, to “text” means to write and send a message using a mobile phone.
She is texting at the moment.

DIG (verb)

Definition: To “dig” means to make a hole in the ground.
I am digging the land.
My mother asks me to dig the soil for her flower.
He is digging the land.

SAVE (verb)

Definition: To “save” means to keep the money.
We save money in a bank
I like to buy that dress but I have to save money first.
They are saving their money.

MONITOR (verb)

Definition: To “monitor” means to check something or someone.
The boss is monitoring the new manager.
The mother is monitoring her children.

HOOR (noun)

Definition: An “hour” is a period of 60 minutes.
She has a swimming lesson for 2 hours.
I am playing basketball for an hour.

DREAM (noun)

Definition: A “dream” is a series of pictures or visions that a sleeping person experiences.
I had a bad dream last night.
The word “dream” can also be a verb.
She is dreaming of me tonight.

PAIN (noun)

Definition: It is a physical hurt or discomfort that is usually caused by injury or illness.
I am feeling the pain now.

TASTE (noun)

Definition: It is a feeling you get from your tongue when you eat or drink.
Sugar has a sweet taste.

She likes the taste of coffee.
The taste of the food is good.

SHOW (verb)

Definition: To “show” something means to let someone see a thing, a place, an action, etc.

I'm showing you my little finger.
I am showing you my book.

EXIST (verb)

Definition: To “exist” means to continue to be present.

My house was built in 2010. It has existed for 13 years.
This building existed for 2 years.

EXISTING (adjective)

Definition: It means something that is still present now.

The problem is still existing.

AWARENESS (noun)

Definition: It means the knowledge and understanding of a particular activity, subject, etc.

For example, “The student's awareness in wearing a uniform is clear.”
Her awareness of the weather is helpful.

AWARE (adjective)

Definition: It means having knowledge of something.

She is aware of the news.

REMAINING (adjective)

Definition: The “remaining” things or people out of a group are the things or people that still exist or are still present.

The remaining eggs are on the table.

WORKING (adjective)

Definition: It used to describe people who work and earn money.

By the words “working student”, we mean a student who is studying and also working.
She is a working student.

RELAX (verb)

Definition: It means to rest or enjoy doing something after work or after study.

If I am not busy with work, I take a rest, and relax.
After studying, I listen to music, I relax after studying.
She is relaxing.

FARMER (noun)

Definition: A “farmer” is a person who works on a farm.

The farmer is planting some vegetables.

My father is a farmer.

MODEL (noun)

Definition: A model is someone who wears or uses the goods of a company. You can see them on TV, in magazines and stores or in shops.

A model doesn't work on a farm.

She is working as a model in a famous clothing company.

PRINCESS (noun)

Definition: A princess is the daughter or granddaughter of a king or queen.

Princess Diana is the princess of Wales.

The princess has a very cute smile.

I wish I were a princess.

PRINCE (noun)

Definition: A prince is the son or grandson of a king or queen.

Prince Charles is the prince of Wales.

The new prince is playing with his classmates.

My sister said that the prince is getting married.

PROFESSOR (noun)

Definition: A professor is someone who works as a teacher at a school or university.

Our professor teaches us how to get the answer.

We have a new professor in our class.

OFFICER (noun)

Definition: An officer is a person who has an important job in a company, school, etc.

The police officer is talking to my mother.

The police officer is working at night.

PRIEST (noun)

Definition: A person who is qualified to perform religious duties and ceremonies in Roman Catholic churches.

My uncle is a priest.

ARMY (noun)

Definition: An army is a group of people who fights for the country on land.

My father is a member of an army.

He is not working in the army.

SOLDIER (noun)

Definition: A soldier is a person who serves in an army.

There are many soldiers in an army.

The soldier is wearing his uniform.

My grandfather was a soldier when he was young.

MEMBERSHIP (noun)

Definition: The word "membership" means the state of being a member.

Some examples are shop memberships, bank memberships or sports memberships and more.

The shop has a large membership.

FORM (noun)

Definition: A "form" is a document where you write something about yourself, like your name, age, etc.

Some examples of forms are school forms, library membership forms, etc.

She is writing on a form.

COLLECTION (noun)

Definition: A "collection" is a gathering of a group of things of the same type.

I have a collection of books.

She has a collection of Haruki Murakami's books and Harry Potter.

CONFERENCE (noun)

Definition: A "conference" is a meeting to discuss a particular matter.

The President is early for the conference.

She joins the conference.

CREDIT (noun)

Definition: A "credit" is an amount of money made available by a bank on which a person may use.

She buys a car on credit.

She has a lot of credit in her bank.

CREDIT CARD (noun)

Definition: A credit card is a small plastic card that you can use to buy something.

I sometimes buy things on credit.

I use my credit card to buy some food or things for work when I do shopping.

I use a credit card when shopping online.

DUTY (noun)

Definition: The word "duty" means work that you have to do as a part of your job.

The duty of a teacher is to teach.

FIRE (verb)

Definition: To "fire" means to make someone leave his or her job.

He was fired for having many absences.

He was fired from his work.

EMAIL (noun)

Definition: An email is a message that you send or receive by computer.

I send emails to my friends every day.

She sends an email message.

EARN (verb)

Definition: To “earn” means to receive money for the work that you do.

In the Philippines, a doctor earns 50,000 pesos a month.

I earn \$4,000 a month.

PRINT (noun)

Definition: A “print” is a copy made by printing.

Some examples of prints are pictures, words, or numbers that you see on the paper.

The print is not clear.

PRINT (verb)

Definition: It means to print pictures, words, or numbers from a computer onto paper.

The teacher printed some pictures for the student.

He prints the picture.

PRINTER (noun)

Definition: A printer is a machine used for printing documents that you have created on a computer.

The printer printed many pictures.

SALE (noun)

Definition 1. It means selling at a price that is lower than the common price.

There is a sale in the shop on Monday.

Definition 2. It is the money received by the company.

The company's sales this year are big.

SAVING (noun)

Definition: It means the money that you saved in the bank.

I put all my savings in the bank.

She has some savings for her son.

STUDIO (noun)

Definition: It means a building or room where we can practice singing and dancing.

We want to have the dance practice at the studio.

She is in the studio for dance practice.

BUSINESS (noun)

Definition: It is the practice of making one's living or making money by producing or buying and selling products.

I have a shoe shop business.

Her business is growing.

LADY (noun)

Definition: The word "lady" is a term for a girl or woman.

The lady is walking on the road.

The lady owns the studio.

WEBSITE (noun)

Definition: A website is a set of data and information about a particular subject that is available on the Internet.

We use different kinds of websites every day, like Google, Yahoo, Facebook, etc.

The website provides pictures of the company.

REMAIN (verb)

Definition: To "remain" means to be in the same place or condition.

The weather remains cold.

The sales of the business remain the same.

QUIT (verb)

Definition: To "quit" means to leave a job or school permanently.

If you quit your job, you choose to leave it.

She quits her work.

LOVER (noun)

Definition: We call someone a "lover" if he/she loves something or someone.

Brad Pitt is Angelina Jolie's lover.

I'm a music lover.

She is somebody's lover.

MARRIED (adjective)

Definition: It means having a husband or wife.

Mr. and Mrs. Timpson are married.

Nobody in my company is married.

PARENT (noun)

Definition: A parent is a mother or father.

The parents of Adam and Sarah Timpson are Lisa and Bob Timpson.

Parents work hard for their children.

Nobody knows where her parents are.

FRIEND (noun)

Definition: It means someone whom you know and like a lot and who is not part of your family.

I play sports with my friends.

I go out for dinner with my friends.
Nobody knows that he is my friend.

PROVIDE (verb)

Definition: To "provide" means to give someone what he/she needs.

Parents provide food for their children.
Nobody provides us with the form.

FIELD (noun)

Definition: The word "field" means an area of interest in work or study.

I work in the business field.
Nobody in this room works in the business field.

TEXT (noun)

Definition 1. When we say "text", it means all the written words in a book, newspaper, etc.

I can't read the text in the book because it's small.
She reads the text in the book.

Definition 2. It is also the message that you receive on your mobile phone.

I received a text from my mother.
I forgot to read her text.

HANG (verb)

Definition: To "hang" means to attach to something above with no support from below.

The light hangs on the ceiling.
The picture hangs on the wall.

HIT (noun)

Definition: It means something that is very successful.

Harry Potter is a big hit.
The movie was a big hit.

HIT (verb)

Definition: When you hit someone or something, you strike them either with an object or with your hand.

I'm hitting the table with my hand.
I'm hitting the wall with my hand.
He hits the wall with the ball.

LAY (verb)

Definition: To "lay" means to put something down.

He laid the baby in the bed.

RUB (verb)

Definition: To "rub" means to move one's hand repeatedly back and forth on the surface with firm pressure.

She is rubbing her hands.

TASTE (verb)

Definition: To "taste" means to eat or drink a small amount of something in order to try its flavor.

I'm tasting my finger.

She tasted the food on the table.

WAVE (verb)

Definition: To "wave" is to move your hand from side to side in the air in order to say hello or goodbye to someone.

He is waving his hand.

ALONE (adjective)

Definition: It means having no one else with you.

I'm the only person in this room now. I'm alone in this room now.

She is alone in the house.

TURN (verb)

Definition: To "turn" means to change.

The water turned black.

Her face turned red.

BECOME (verb)

Definition: To "become" means to change and start to be something different.

I become happy after eating my meal.

She becomes happy.

REMAINING (adjective)

Definition: The "remaining" things or people out of a group are the things or people that still exist or are still present.

The remaining things are still left after other things have gone.

The remaining food is on the table.

BELIEVE (verb)

Definition: To "believe" means to think that something is true or correct.

If you are thinking that it will rain later, you can say "I believe that it will rain later".

She believes that going to church is better than going to malls.

I believed that there will be no school tomorrow.

SUGGEST (verb)

Definition: To “suggest” means to offer an idea or a plan for someone to consider.

I suggest that you should sleep early.

I suggest that you go home early today.

We suggested that we go to the village this summer.

He suggested that we take a bus in going to school.

AGREE (verb)

Definition: When you agree with someone, you share the same opinion, feeling, or purpose.

If someone said that Angelina Jolie is beautiful, you can say “I agree that Angelina Jolie is beautiful”.

I agree that you should stay home and relax.

Do you agree that the song is good?

He didn't agree with our teacher.
