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





I see a fly.

three candies



I see a candy.

Irregular Plural Nouns



a goose

two geese

This is a goose.

These are two geese.



a tooth

three teeth

This is a tooth.

These are three teeth.

Another example: foot – feet

deer -- deer




a **deer**

This is a deer.

These are two deer.



a **sheep**

four **sheep**

This is a sheep.

These are four sheep.







1. Regular Plural Nouns: *y - i + es*




e.g. fly - flies
