

Language Focus

Superlative adjective: expresses the extreme or highest degree of a quality

Noun (subject) + verb + the + superlative adjective + noun (object).

Examples:

My sister is the tallest in our family.

My mother is the most careful person I know.

I can run the fastest in my family.

Our neighbors think my grandmother is the nicest person they know.

He is the smartest among the siblings.

How to make superlatives

1 syllable adjectives. Add the /adj. / est.

E.g.: cool = the coolest

2+ syllable adjectives. Add the most to the adjective

E.g.: powerful = the most powerful

Adjectives ending in -y. Remove -y and add the /adj. / iest.

E.g.: funny = the funniest

Adjectives ending in -e. Add the /adj. / st.

E.g.: large = the largest

Irregular adjectives.

E.g.: good = the best

Adjectives ending in a vowel and a consonant. Double the final consonant and add the /adj. / est.

E.g.: slim = the slimmest
