

Present Progressive (be verb + verb - ing) - we use this for an action we are doing now.

Fred is reading the book.

Ana is washing her face.

He is driving to work.

I am eating breakfast.

They are watching TV.

She is sleeping.

Present Simple (base form of the verb) - we use this for an action we usually do.

Fred reads a book in his free time.

Ana washes her face in the morning.

He drives his car to work.

I eat breakfast.

They watch television in the evening.

She sleeps at night.
