

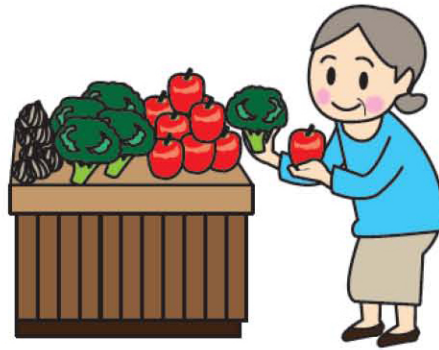

## Useful Quantity Expressions

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plenty of</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>enough of something</li> </ul> <p>ex: I have plenty of time.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>too much</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>more than enough of something (uncountable)</li> </ul> <p>ex: I don't want too much sugar in my tea.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>too many</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>more than enough of something (countable in plural form)</li> </ul> <p>ex: There are too many people in the train.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>all of / all</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>100 % of something</li> </ul> <p>ex: All of my paper are gone.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a little</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>small amount of something (uncountable)</li> </ul> <p>ex: Can I have a little sugar, please?</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a few</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>small amount of something (countable in plural forms)</li> </ul> <p>ex: The market is just a few meters away.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>none of</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>nothing at all</li> </ul> <p>ex: None of the class pass the exam.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>any</li> <li>some</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>questions and negative sentences</li> </ul> <p>ex: She doesn't have any questions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>positive sentences</li> </ul> <p>ex: I have some questions to ask you.</p>
