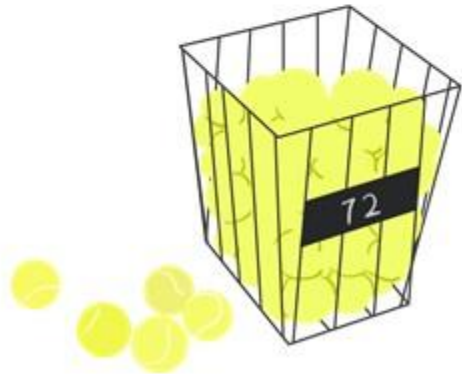

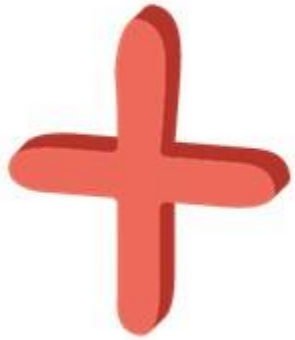

A plus B is...

$$3 + 2 = 5$$

$$15 + 10 = 25$$

3 plus 2 is 5.

15 plus 10 is 25.



A minus B is...

$$3 - 2 = 1$$

$$15 - 10 = 5$$

3 minus 2 is 1.

15 minus 10 is 5.



Read and learn



A times B is...

$$4 \times 2 = 8$$

$$3 \times 3 = 9$$

4 times 2 is 8.

3 times 3 is 9.



A divided by B is...

$$4 \div 2 = 2$$

$$6 \div 2 = 3$$

4 divided by 2 is 2.

6 divided by 2 is 3.
