- Allen is **dirty**.
Annie is dirtier than Allen.
- Annie's **sandcastle** is tall.
It is taller than Allen's sandcastle.

Read and learn: **the** + “-est”



Your sandcastle is *the tallest* on the beach.



Annie

Sam

Mom

Annie is **tall**.

Sam is **taller than** Annie.

Mom is **the tallest**.

More examples: **the** + “-est”



The dolphin is **big**.

The shark **is bigger than** the dolphin.

The whale is **the biggest**.



The blue balloon is **small**.

The red balloon **is smaller than** the blue one.

The orange balloon is **the smallest**.
