Primary Schools in China and America



There are primary schools in each country. What do you know about the primary schools in America? Are they different from those in China?

Of course, the answer is “yes”. In China, there are more students in each classroom and they usually sit in lines, while in America, students sit around the tables. In class, they learn different subjects. Students in China have Chinese lessons, while in America they have language arts and social studies. Language arts is about English grammar, vocabulary, reading and writing. Social studies is about American history and geography.

Besides the differences, primary schools in America and China are six-year schools. And students can get their books for free in the 6 years.

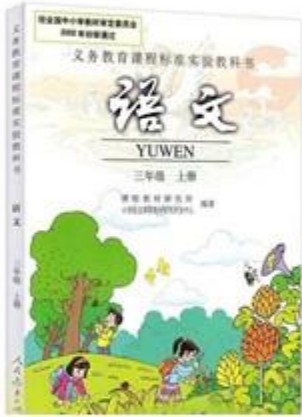

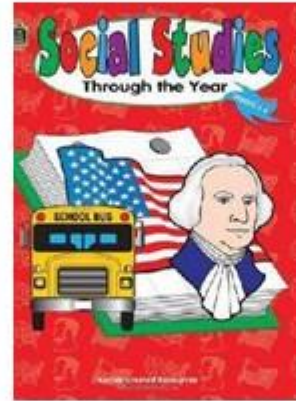
