

#### Read and learn

Sam: What did you eat for Christmas dinner?

Annie: I ate some Christmas cake.

Sam: Wow! Who made the Christmas cake?

Annie: My mom made it.

She <u>also</u> cooked a delicious Christmas goose.



### Read and learn: the usage of "also"

also: be + also / also + verb

be + also

- 1. Sam is in class 2 grade 4. Alice is also in Class 2 Grade 4.
- 2. Annie is in the library. Allen and Lucy are also in the library.

also + verb

- 3. I bought some milk. He also bought some milk.
- 4. Allen plays football. He also plays table tennis.

### Read and learn: the difference between "too" and "also"



also (in the middle) → be + also / also + verb too (at the end) → ..., too.

She **also** cooked a Christmas goose. = She cooked a Christmas goose**, too**.

My mom made some cookies, she \_\_\_\_ (made) an apple pie. The apple pie was big. It's delicious, \_\_\_\_\_.
