Read and learn

A *sends...to* B.
= B *receives...from* A.



Alice **sends** gingerbread **to** Allen.
=Allen **receives** gingerbread **from** Alice.



Teacher **receives** flowers **from** Annie.
=Annie **sends** flowers **to** teacher.
