Lesson 6 • Review Time

After Christmas dinner, grandpa read a story about Santa Claus for kids.

Santa Claus lives in the North Pole. Before Christmas, children write letters and tell him their Christmas wishes. On Christmas Eve, he rides on the **sleigh** pulled by **reindeers** and comes to us.
