Go to bed late — stay very small.



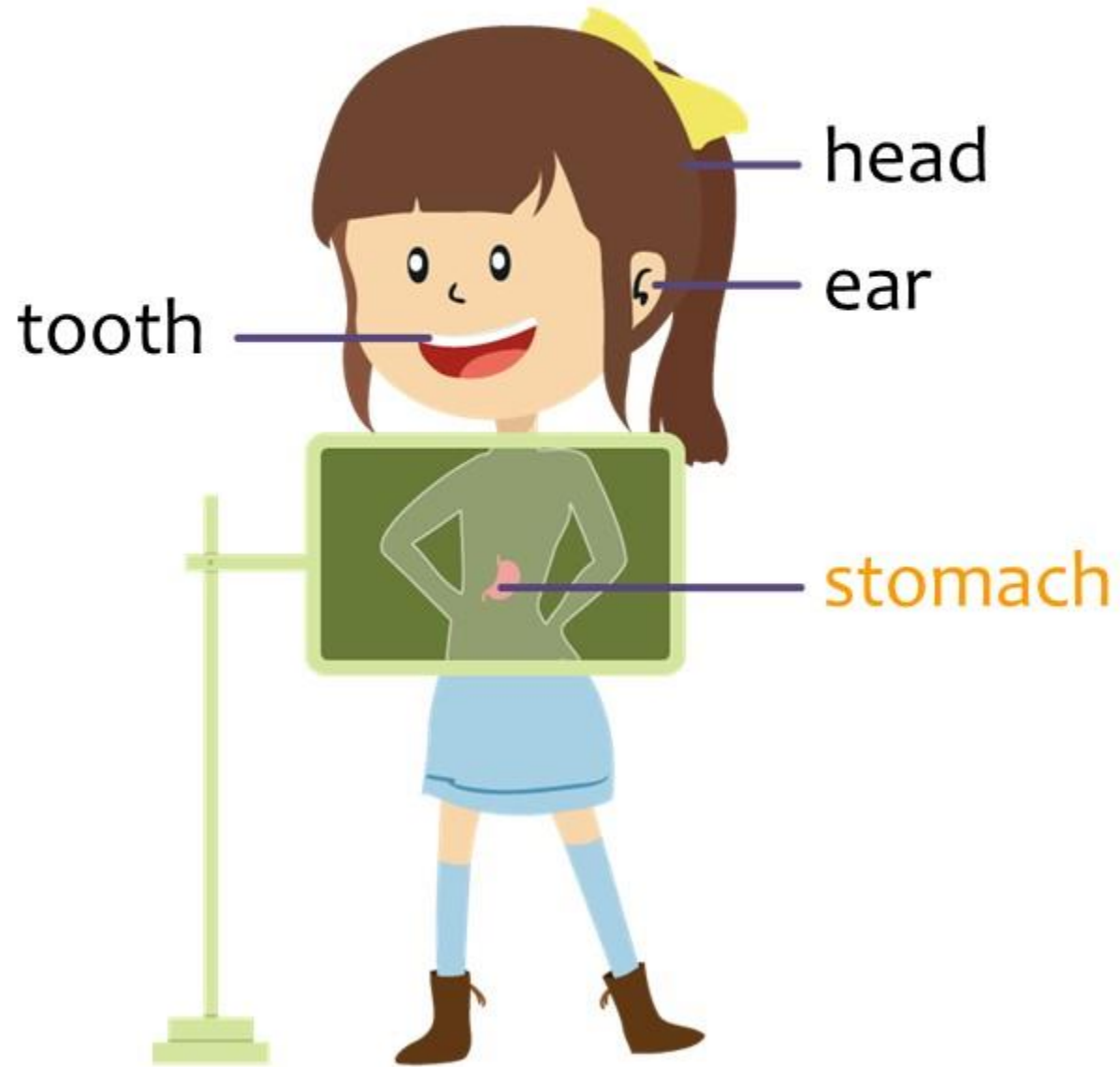

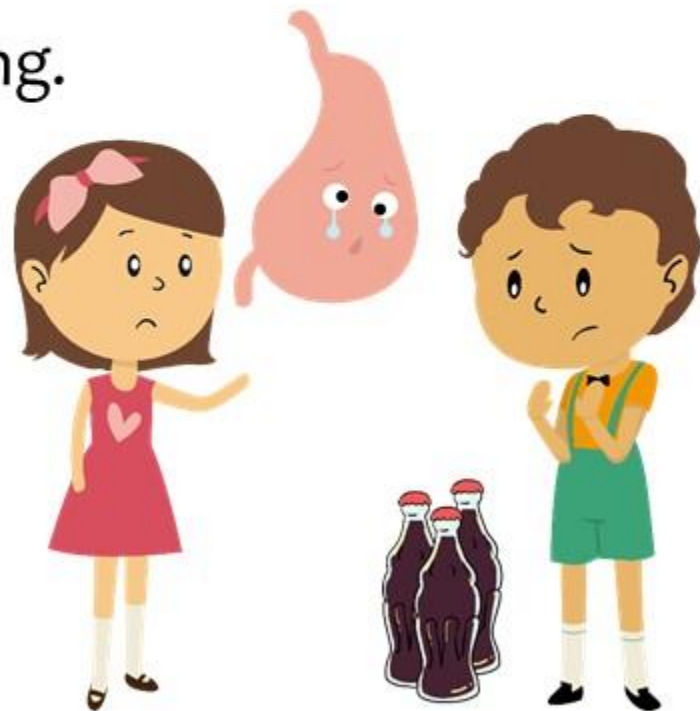
**Annie:** I always get up early, but I **got** up late this morning.

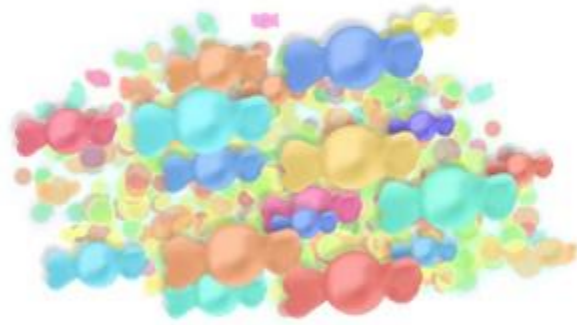

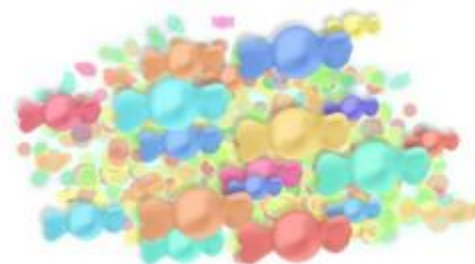

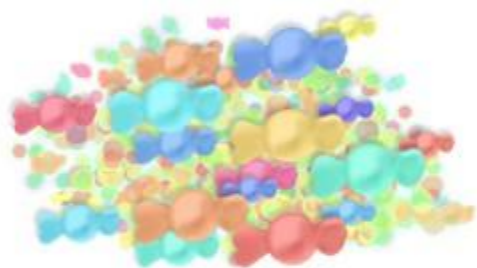
