


Chopsticks

These are the Chinese,


Japanese, and Korean chopsticks.



Read and learn

The Chinese chopsticks are made of wood, shaped like a rectangle and have blunt ends. They are the longest and the thickest type of chopsticks.

The Japanese chopsticks are also made of wood. They are the shortest and have pointy ends.

Lastly, the Korean chopsticks are flat and made of metal. They have blunt ends and the hardest to use too. Do you know why the Koreans use metal chopsticks? So ordinary people started using chopsticks that are made of metal.
